

DESCRIPTION

Organization

The National Organization Hydrogen and Fuel Cell Technology is organizing the national school student competition “hydrogen and fuel cell” as a special award within the *Jugend forscht* (Youth researches) competition, a well-established German youth competition on natural science and technology.

This special award will be awarded on state level through the respective *Jugend forscht* state juries, thereby awarding a maximum of 16 special awards – one in each state.

A jury put together by NOW, then selects a national winner from the group of state winners. Due to tight deadlines the state winners hand in their winning projects and are not given new tasks.

Target group

The *Jugend forscht* competition is divided into two age groups: School students under the age of 14 compete in the category *Schüler experimentieren* (school students experimenting). Students between 15 and 21 compete in the *Jugend forscht* competition.

It is very likely that almost only the older group will send in contributions for the special award “hydrogen and fuel cell”. However, contributions from younger students should not be categorically excluded, but dealt with on a case-by-case basis.

Topic/Task

In order to qualify for the special award “hydrogen and fuel cell” contributions need to deal “hydrogen and fuel cell technology”. Further specification is not necessary.
